

# OPNAVINST 5090.1B, Change 3

## Chapter 11 PCB Management Ashore

### **What was changed?**

The second to last sentence in 11-3.4 defining PCB and PCBs was re-written.

11-4.1 was reworded and updated to reflect a change in the references listed and the order it appeared.

The last sentence in 11-5.1 discussing the calculation of pure PCBs spilled was re-worded.

The first sentence of 11-5.4 was re-numbered and re-worded.

The first sentence of 11-5.5 (a)(1) discussing transformers was re-numbered and re-worded.

The first sentence of 11-5.5 (b)(1) discussing capacitors was re-numbered and re-worded

The first sentence of 11-5.5 (d)(1)-(4) was re-numbered and re-worded to replace the word DBOF (Defense Business Operating Funds) to NWCF (Navy Working Capital Funding).

The last sentence of 11-5.6 discussing training was re-numbered and re-worded.

### **What was added?**

No additions

### **What was deleted?**

11-6.4 (c) regarding the claimant and subordinate command requirement that annual PCB reports are to be submitted to the claimant by 31 January for the previous calendar year was deleted.

The second sentence in 11-6.5 (f) indicating “Copies of the completed annual report shall be forwarded annually by 31 January to the major claimant, who is in turn responsible for forwarding the report to NFESC by 28 February was deleted” was deleted.

Section 11-5.2 indicating “All Navy shore activities that generate, use, treat, store, and/or dispose of PCBs shall annually inventory or validate all PCBs and PCB items per the procedures published by NFESC and as required by applicable Federal and State regulations” was deleted.
